TRESTLEBOARD December 2021

From the East:

It has been an interest couple years serving in the East. My final message as Master will be a short review of the masonic years 2020 and 2021.

We started the year 2020 with enthusiasm, approving our budget and announcing committee members, as per code requirements. Visiting other lodges, improving neighborhood relations and degree work were the expanding focus of lodge activities.

However, with the emerging threat of COVID-19, March would be our last stated meeting dinner, a traditional Irish dish, cottage pie. We had an EA and FC degree scheduled, but we were forced into lock down before we could confer them. We would remain in lockdown until after the Grand Lodge Annual Communication was held in June in a modified format with only 25 in attendance. Though we would not be allowed to confer degrees, we were encourage to meet for the Stated Meetings as listed in our charter, following restrictions and protocols related to the pandemic.

September would have been a regular meeting, but we did not reach quorum due to Wild Fires and poor air quality. For the October meeting we were able to resume operations and mailed out scholarships, as we were still not able to receive guests. We were able to hold Elections in November, although this was the beginning of the repeat year. All elected officers stood and were reelected to their 2020 offices for the 2021 year.

We started the installation process in December, as we were restricted to only six brothers in attendance at one time. The next group was installed in January, and we finished the installation process in February with the Senior Steward and Tyler.

Even though we increased our charitable donations in 2020, with double our normal donation to the Community Transitional School (CTS), plus donations to Fire Relief efforts, as well as some individual charities, our overall lack of spending and having our investments do well, brought us back up to \$2 million in assets.

A year after lock down and the lodge was still being forced into doing minimal work. It would not be until after Grand Lodge Annual Communication in June of 2021 that we would start to see regulations lifted. This allowed us to confer the FC degree that had been put on hold, and hold our annual picnic in July, before restrictions returned in the fall.

In a repeat of 2020, we were able to mail scholarship awards and hold elections in November of 2021. Which brings us to December, with our **Annual Installation of Officers** scheduled for **December 18th at 12 noon**, and the elected line moving once again. I look forward to the continued progress of the lodge. I have faith in the officers of this lodge, and trust that whatever decisions are made for our future, they will be made with harmony in mind.
