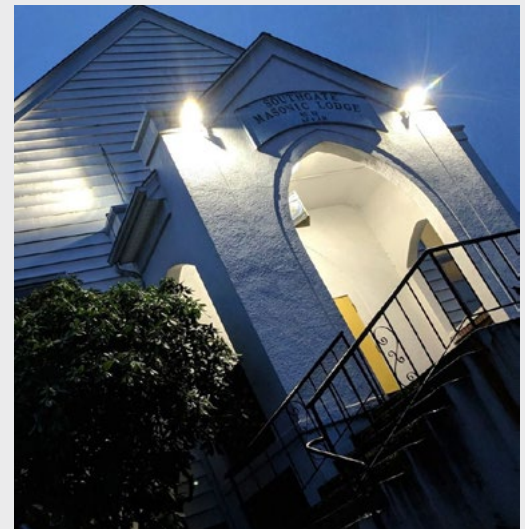
Cornerstone lodge thanks all who attended and worked the annual Easter (this year vigil)
